SCHEDULE OF FEES

As an integrated school Sacred Heart College receives funding from the Government. However this operating grant covers only a portion of the costs associated with providing a well-rounded education. For Sacred Heart to operate effectively, it is important that all families pay both the Attendance Dues and our school fees.

ATTENDANCE DUES

Attendance Dues of \$716.00 are invoiced by, and paid to the Catholic Schools Board Ltd Wellington. This is used to pay existing debt, and to provide additional buildings for the Catholic schools in New Zealand. The College's gymnasium, and most recently the refurbished Technology and Social Science facilities were funded by the Catholic Schools Board.

SCHOOL FEE (DONATION)

The School Fee of \$140.00 is invoiced by Sacred Heart and supplements the College's operating costs. As a donation this is not a compulsory fee but assists educational, cultural, sporting and social activities such as the library, minibus, visiting speakers and groups, prizegiving, computer and technology equipment. \$30 of this donation is a Proprietors' Levy used to support the Catholic Character within the school in such areas as professional and curriculum development, the Youth Minister, Religious Education textbooks and liturgical celebrations.

TAXATION REBATE

The School Fee Donation may be claimed as a rebate against income for taxation purposes. This is claimed once a year through the Inland Revenue Department.

OTHER FEES

As is consistent with other secondary schools and Ministry of Education policy, some subjects in the school attract curriculum fees. These are for those subjects which have a product component, have field trips or compulsory write-on study books.

Extra-curricular activities such as sports teams and Stage Challenge are paid on a participation basis and parents are informed of these costs at the time of their daughter selecting the activity. Participation in these activities is dependent upon the associated fee being paid.

Students using school buses from Taradale and Tamatea will need to purchase bus tickets from Metro Rentals, our bus provider. A taxi service is available from Havelock North to Hastings. This fee is payable to the school each term.
